You've signed up for a reading challenge, you've read your first book and reviewed it, and now you're ready to share it with the challenge host. You can do this!

1. Sign into GoodReads and find the book however you would normally do that. (Search bar, My Books, etc.)
2. Click on See Review below your review excerpt (Circled in red below)

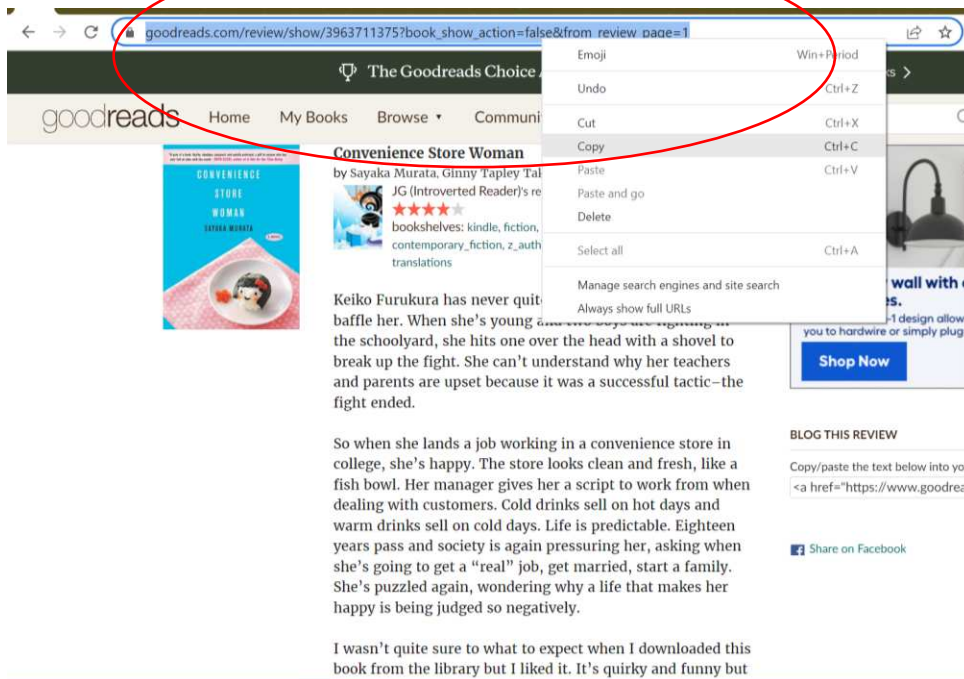

6. Paste your GoodReads link in the “Your URL” box. Click the “Check to accept” box and click Enter.
